Program Updates

- SB 21-098 - PDMP Sunset Reauthorization, authorizes Board of Pharmacy to require reporting of non-controlled drugs of concern
- HB 21-1012 - Allow Board of Pharmacy to consider require reporting of all prescriptions
- HB 21-1276 - PDMP use mandate for certain opioid and benzodiazepine prescriptions, require PDMP to offer RxCheck for integration with EHRs and other health information systems



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Program Updates

- Rule 23 Update - Effective 11/30/2021, pharmacies will be required to report Date Sold, Drug Dosage Units, and submit daily Zero Reports when no controlled substance prescriptions are sold.
- Request for Proposals (RFP) - Released September 2021
- PDMP OSA Audit Update
